





Currently, 58.8% of the 66,628 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.2%, renter occupied; and 7.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.9% are renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. In 2010, there were 66,192 housing units in the area – 60.6% owner occupied, 31.3% renter occupied, and 8.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.09%. Median home value in the area is \$185,074, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.47% annually to \$209,076.
